Candidate Eligibility:

- Enrolled as a student at an Orange County College or University.
- An active member in good standing of a Circle K or Kiwanis Club.
- Have a 2.5 GPA or better.
- Has accumulated community service hours as a college student. Strong consideration will be given to those members who have participated in events sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Orange.
- Is available to receive the scholarship from the Kiwanis Club of Orange during our Annual Scholarship Dinner (Date and location to be determined).
- Provide a written statement of why they should be considered for this scholarship award, the type of community service they performed, and how they have demonstrated leadership as a club member or volunteer in the community. The statement should also include a brief description of their future goals, planned educational major or career choice and what inspired you to get involved in community service with a description of the projects that have been the most memorable. This statement should not exceed two pages.
- A service club advisor or other service organization representative will be asked to validate the candidate's eligibility and provide a personal recommendation as to why this candidate should be awarded a scholarship.
- Complete the accompanying 'Scholarship Application' and return it to the Kiwanis Post Office Box. The return envelope must be postmarked by **Monday, April 17, 2017**. No late applications will be accepted.
