High School Scholarship Application Packet 2017

The Kiwanis Club of Orange is pleased to offer scholarships for Orange and Villa Park students graduating in 2017 and that plan to attend a Community College, University or Vocational school in the Fall. All scholarship candidates must have a proven history of involvement in community service through their high school Key Club (a sponsored youth program of Kiwanis International), faith based, or other nonprofit organization.

Key Club Members from Orange, El Modena, Lutheran, and Villa Park High Schools are strongly encouraged to apply. Although, Key Club membership is not a requirement, a student's membership and participation in projects sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Orange will be considered in the review process.

Kiwanis Club of Orange Scholarship Winners will receive a minimum award of \$500, but may be eligible for additional funding. Final scholarship awards are dependent upon the maximum discretionary amount approved by the Board of Directors. Applications are due on or before Monday, April 17, 2017 and Scholarship Winners will be notified by the end of the school year.

Primary funding for the Kiwanis Club of Orange Scholarship Program comes from "The Dale Watt Memorial" and "The Linda Graff Memorial" Funds. In addition, the club will award scholarships in the name of long-time members Milfred Smith and Larry Allan, who passed away in 2014.

Candidate Eligibility Checklist:

- The candidate must be enrolled as a student at one of the following high schools: El Modena, Orange, Orange Lutheran, Richland or Villa Park and meet the other requirements listed below.
- The candidate must be in his/her final year of high school.
- The candidate must have a 3.5 GPA or better.
- The candidate must have accumulated community service hours (verified by school faculty, church or nonprofit representative).
- The candidate must be present to receive the scholarship from the Kiwanis Club of Orange during our Annual Scholarship Dinner (Date and location to be determined).
- The candidate must have or be able to demonstrate that he/she is eligible to receive a high school diploma or the equivalent before the scholarship will be awarded.
- Each candidate will provide a written statement of why they should be considered for this scholarship award, the type of community service they have performed and how they have demonstrated leadership as a club member or volunteer in the community. Please also include:
 - **What inspired you to get involved with community service?**
 - **What projects have been the most memorable?**
 - **How has your experience changed your view of the world?**
 - **The candidate should also briefly describe their future goals including planned major and career choice.**
 - **This statement should not exceed two pages**
- A service club advisor or other service organization representative will be asked to validate the candidate's eligibility and provide a personal recommendation as to why this candidate should be awarded a scholarship.
- The candidate must complete the attached 'Scholarship Application' and return it with their written statement to Kiwanis Club of Orange (see address below) on or before **April 17, 2017**. No late applications will be accepted.
